The Regular Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled on Wednesday, August 01, 2018 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Russell Rohlman, Ken Carroll, Quinn Jacobs, Ed Burch, Eladio Reid and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was present.

Mayor Pence invited the public to present comments to the governing Body.

Approval of Agenda:

Burch moved to approve the Agenda. Seconded by Rohlman. Motion carried

Approval of Minutes:

Clerk commented that the minutes from the 7/18/18 Council Meeting are not completed and ready for approval.

Jim Armendarez, Principal of Ogden Elementary; Request donation from City for 100 year Anniversary Celebration of Ogden Elementary.

Armendarez requested a donation from the City of up to \$1000 to help support the 100 year celebration of Ogden Elementary that will occur on October 6th.

Burch moved to authorize the expenditure of up to \$1000 donation to help support the 100 year celebration of Ogden Elementary. Seconded by Reid. Jacobs and Rohlman expressed reservations as to the amount of the donation being too high. Burch, Reid and Jacobs voted in favor. Carroll and Rohlman voted against. Motion carried.

Angela Schnee, Code Enforcement Officer; Discussion of RCPD Enforcement of STO with regards to parking and nuisances in the City Right of Way.

Schnee presented the Council with a memo and pictures of abandoned and junk vehicles as well as nuisances in the City's right of way. She commented that she can't right tickets and enforce issues that arise in the City's ROW(Public Property). That is an RCPD matter and at this time they are unwilling to write tickets. She commented that her authority on exists on private property. She commented that RCPD has suggested a process in which the public is educated that RCPD will start enforcing the ROW issues with regards to abandoned, inoperable, junk vehicles.

Consensus of the Council was to move forward with the education process to enforce the STO with regards to the City Right of Way.

Rohlman moved to authorize Attorney Irvine to draft an ordinance designating three spaces in front of the Post Office as "Post Office Parking Only from 10a.m. to 4p.m." Seconded by Carroll. Rohlman, Carroll and Burch voted in favor. Jacobs and Reid opposed. Motion carried.

Rohlman moved to rescind the action of the Governing Body on its previous motion that authorized the donation of \$1000 donation to help support the 100 year celebration of Ogden Elementary. Seconded by Jacobs.

Carroll moved to authorize the expenditure of up to \$750 to help support the 100 year celebration of Ogden Elementary. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.


Mayor Pence commented that August 12th will be the final day for the pool to be open.
