May 21, 2014

The Regular Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled on Wednesday, May 21, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Paul Werle, Ken Carroll, Ed Burch, Brian Still and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was present.

Mayor Pence invited the public to present comments to the Governing Body.

Approval of Agenda:

Mayor Pence requested that an Executive Session for Non-Elected Personnel be placed after item number 10 on the agenda.

Carroll moved to approve the Agenda with the addition. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes:

Burch commented that on page 2 of the May 7, 2014 minutes, *Seconded by Burch and motion carried* were omitted from the motion to adopt Ordinance 697.

Clerk commented that he would make that correction.

Carroll moved to approve the Minutes of the May 6 and May 7, 2014 Council Meetings with the correction. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Matthew Jacquier, Ogden Cub Scouts: Request permission to set up a temporary BB Gun Range in the City Park or in the Community Center.

Ryan Pickens, was present, representing Matthew Jacquier.

Pickens commented that they would like to set up a BB Gun Range as well as a range for bow and arrows.

Council discussed possible options for the Cub Scouts.

Carroll move to allow the Cub Scouts to use the Community Center to set up a BB Gun and Bow and Arrow Range in the Community Center on May 27th and May 28th. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Randall Hobbs: Request for an Occupational License for Hobbs Lawn Care at 533 14th Street.

Burch moved to grant Randall Hobbs and Occupational License for Hobbs Lawn Care at 533 14th Street. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Jennifer Phillips: Exception to Chapter 2 Article 115 Vicious Animals.

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Attorney Irvine commented that the Service Animal Registry that Jennifer Phillips has provided the City for an Emotional Support Animal would not qualify the dog to be in the City under the City's ordinances.

Phillips commented that she has spoken to a lawyer.

Attorney Irvine requested that Phillips have her lawyer contact him.

Adopt Ordinance No. 698. AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ARTICLE 1 OF CHAPTER 2 OF THE CITY OF OGDEN, KANSAS, PERTAINING TO VICIOUS ANIMALS.

Burch moved to adopt Ordinance No. 698. Seconded by Carroll. Motion carried.

Bills of the month.

Burch commented that he has reviewed the Bills of the Month and found them to be acceptable.

City Attorney: Misc. Items.

Attorney Irvine commented that he has some things that he is working on and may have them ready for the next meeting.

City Clerk: Misc. Items.

Clerk commented that Dominick Torres looked at the City's backhoe motor and stated that it needs to be rebuilt or replaced because of some blow-by issues.

Clerk presented the Council an estimate from Torres for an in-frame rebuild for \$4,400 and a long block for \$8,760.

Clerk commented that he has contacted CTI out of Wamego to give the city a second opinion and estimate.

Clerk commented that he contacted the Mayor and got authorization to rent a backhoe while the City's is being repaired.

Werle moved to give Mayor Pence the authority to spend up to \$10,000 to do repairs on the City's back hoe. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Mayor & Council: Misc. Items.

Carroll commented that currently the City has three lifeguards that are certified.

Council discussed possible solutions to getting more lifeguard candidates certified and remedies to keeping the pool open on its regularly scheduled hours.

Burch commented that the Water Rate Study has been completed and that water rates need to be looked at for possible modification.

Burch commented that he has a list of things for the City Foreman and will give it to the Clerk to pass on to the new City Foreman when he starts on June 2nd.

Still commented that the Boy Scouts are looking for projects and suggested that they contact the new City Foreman to see if he has anything that they could do as a project.

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Still inquired whether S. Park St. was on Burch's list for the new Foreman, commenting that it is in serious need of repair.

Executive Session: Non -Elected Personnel Issues.

Werle moved to recess into Executive Session until 7:50 p.m. for Non-Elected Personnel Issues. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.


Werle moved to return to Regular Session. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Mayor Pence commented that there seems to be a resurgence of drug activity in town and that he noticed that other communities have placed Meth Watch signs in their towns and thought that this may be a good idea for our community.

Werle moved to authorize the purchase of four Meth Watch signs to be placed throughout the City. Seconded by Carroll. Motion carried.

Burch moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Werle . Motion carried.
