The Regular Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled on Wednesday, September 17, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Paul Werle, Ed Burch, Brian Still and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was present.

Mayor Pence invited the public to present comments to the Governing Body.

Approval of Agenda:

Burch moved to approve the Agenda. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes:

Burch commented that his name had been omitted from the minutes as being present at the September 03, 2014 Council Meeting.

Burch moved to approve the Minutes of the September 03, 2014 Council Meeting with the correction. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Charlene McKinney, Rockhouse Sports Bar: Annual renewal of Liquor License.

Werle moved to grant Charlene McKinney, Rockhouse Sports Bar the annual renewal of her Liquor License. Seconded by Burch. Motion Carried.

Write Off of Utility Bad Debts.

Consensus of the Council was to have the Clerk look into the possibility of pursuing these bad debts through a collection agency.

Burch moved to write off utility bad debts in the amount of \$1411.10. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

City Foreman: Misc. Items.

Nations commented that he has completed crack sealing Riley Ave and starting tomorrow the crew will start crack sealing in the housing additions north of 16th street.

Nations presented the Council with a bid proposal from Bobcat on a skidloader for a yearly renewable lease for a 5 yr. period at \$3200 per year with a 350hr allowance per year.

Carroll moved to accept the bid proposal from Bobcat at \$3200 per year for 5 years. Seconded by Werle. Motion carried.

Carroll commented that it was brought to his attention that there may be a need for an ice machined at the Community Center.


Werle commented that the maintenance and repair on ice machines can be very expensive and suggested that leasing might be a better option.
