ORDINANCE NO. 729

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATION IN THE 300TH BLOCK OF RILEY AVENUE ADJACENT TO THE UNITED STATES POST OFFICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OGDEN, KANSAS:

Section 1. Three parking stalls on Riley Avenue adjacent to the United States Post Office located at 310 Riley Avenue, shall be and are hereby restricted for use by patrons of the Post Office in accordance with the provision of this ordinance.

Section 2. The restricted stalls shall only be used by patrons of the United States Post Office between the hours of 10:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. on such days when the Post Office is open for business.

<u>Section 3.</u> No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle in any of the restricted stalls, except in accordance with the provision of this ordinance.

<u>Section 4.</u> The City is authorized to erect signs prohibiting parking as set forth in this ordinance.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
