ORDINANCE NO. 722

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE RIVERTRAIL SUBDIVISION IN THE CITY OF OGDEN, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OGDEN, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The maximum speed on Cimarron Trail is hereby established at 35 miles per hour, and no person shall operate a motor vehicle in excess of such maximum speed. Signs with the maximum speed shall be erected on said street.

<u>Section 2.</u> All persons operating motor vehicles traveling on Old Pawnee Trail shall be controlled by a stop sign at the intersection with Cimarron Trail. Stop signs shall be erected on Old Pawnee Trail indicating the same.

<u>Section 3.</u> All persons operating motor vehicles traveling on Wilderness Trail shall be controlled by a stop sign at the intersection with Cimarron Trail. Stop signs shall be erected on Wilderness Trail indicating the same.

<u>Section 4.</u> This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
