

ORDINANCE NO. 722

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE RIVERTRAIL SUBDIVISION IN THE CITY OF OGDEN, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OGDEN, KANSAS:


Section 1. The maximum speed on Cimarron Trail is hereby established at 35 miles per hour, and no person shall operate a motor vehicle in excess of such maximum speed. Signs with the maximum speed shall be erected on said street.

Section 2. All persons operating motor vehicles traveling on Old Pawnee Trail shall be controlled by a stop sign at the intersection with Cimarron Trail. Stop signs shall be erected on Old Pawnee Trail indicating the same.

Section 3. All persons operating motor vehicles traveling on Wilderness Trail shall be controlled by a stop sign at the intersection with Cimarron Trail. Stop signs shall be erected on Wilderness Trail indicating the same.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
