# CITY OF OGDEN

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September 03, 2014

The Regular Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled on Wednesday, September 03, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Ken Carroll, Paul Werle, Brian Still and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was present.

Mayor Pence invited the public to present comments to the Governing Body.

Approval of Agenda:

Burch moved to approve the Agenda. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes:

Carroll moved to approve the Minutes of the August 20, 2014 Council Meeting. Seconded by Werle. Motion carried.

B & K Enterprises, Inc.: Request for Occupational License at 515 Riley Ave.

Burch moved B & K Enterprises, Inc. an Occupational License for vending/coin operated machines at 515 Riley Ave. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Richard Faulkner, Building Inspector: Electric and Gas Inspection.

Faulkner commented that the Council asked him to check with the gas and electric company to see if they would be willing to do the inspections.

Faulkner commented that he spoke with Rusty Allison with Westar Energy and he was informed that they would be willing to inspect the outside the outside connection and they would not be responsible for any inside inspection. He commented that they would need a letter from the City requesting that they do the inspection. He commented that Westar would address emergency situations if a windstorm came through and ripped out services after normal work hours.

Faulkner commented that he spoke with Ken Conrad with Kansas Gas. He commented that they would do the inspections if we requested it. He commented that they would have to have an engineer come out to do the pressure test and then have a technician come out and turn the gas on. He commented that they do not come out after hour unless it is below freezing and a customer is in need of heat.

Faulkner turned in his resignation and commented that his last day of work would be September 19, 2014. He commented that he wanted to that thank the Council for the opportunity to have served them and the citizens of Ogden.

Werle moved to turn the inspection process over to Westar Energy and Kansas Gas. Seconded by Carroll. Motion carried.

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Adopt an Ordinance adopting the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities.

Adopt an Ordinance adopting the Uniform Public Offense Code.

Werle moved to adopt Ordinance Number 670 an Ordinance adopting the Standard Traffic Ordinance for Kansas Cities and Ordinance Number 671 and Ordinance adopting the Uniform Public Offense Code. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

City Foreman: Misc. Items.

Nations commented that he has completed chip sealing 8 blocks and is finished chip sealing for the year.

Nations commented that the paint sprayer is broke and will need to be shipped to Wichita for repair.

City Clerk: Misc. Items.

Clerk presented the Council with a quote from Manko Windows for \$4,602 to install handicap door mechanisms at the Community Center and a quote from Economy Electric for \$295 to run electricity to the doors.

Werle moved to accept the quotes. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Clerk presented the Council with quote to provide electrical service to the park on Elm St.

Consensus of the Council was to look at the Master Plan for the parks on the south end of the city and to see where the most feasible place would be to put electricity.

Carroll suggested that before a new program is started in the parks and recreation department that the Councilperson who works with parks and recreation be made aware of the new program. That way the Councilperson can bring it before the Governing Body.

Consensus of the Council agreed.


Clerk requested permission to enroll in the Muncipal Clerks Institute the first week of November in Wichita.
