The Regular Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled on Wednesday, June 01, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Roger Graham, Ken Carroll, Jim Arp, Ed Burch, Eladio Reid and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was present.

Mayor Pence invited the public to present comments to the governing Body.

Approval of Agenda:

Burch moved to approve the Agenda. Seconded by Arp. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes:

Carroll moved to approve the minutes from the 05 /18/16 Council Meeting. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Kristina Pelky, DBA as Los Toritos LLC; Request Occupational License for Liberty Food Store at 301 Riley Ave.

Burch moved to grant Kristina Pelky, DBA Los Toritos LLC an Occupational License for Liberty Food Store at 301 Riley Avenue. Seconded by Arp. Motion carried.

Kristina Pelky, DBA as Los Toritos LLC; Request Food Service Permit for Liberty Food Store and Diner at 301 Riley Ave.

Carroll moved to grant Kristina Pelky, DBA Los Toritos LLC a Food Service Permit for Liberty Food Store and Diner at 301 Riley Ave. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Ken Carroll- VFW: Request for Sale of Fireworks Permit in the City Park and Donation Towards Night Display.

Carroll commented that he wanted to propose the possibility of something different this year. He commented that there was a problem with supplier last year getting them the product they had ordered.

He commented that Terry Morrard, who sets off the Night Display informed him that he found someone who could get the product he wants for \$2227 for the Night Display and for \$111 the product can be dropped in Topeka from St Joseph Missouri for Morrard to pick up. He commented that in order for that to happen there would have to be a letter from the City on City

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Letterhead stating that Terry Morrand is the shooter for the City and allowed to pick up fireworks for the City and that the Fireworks would have to be picked up in a city truck.

Attorney Irvine commented that in the past it would be the VFW putting on the display and the City would be making a donation and under this scenario it would be the City's display.

Burch moved to grant the VFW a Sale of Fireworks Permit in the City Park July 1-4 and to waive subsequent fee and to authorize a \$750 donation towards the Night Display and to allow the discharge of Fireworks in the City Parks July 1-4. Seconded by Graham. Motion carried.

Bills of the Month.

Burch commented that he has reviewed the Bills of the Month and found them to be acceptable.

City Foreman: Misc. Items.


Nations commented that he had to purchase new tires for the Bobcat in order to get started on City Wide Clean up.
