October 1, 2014

The Regular Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled on Wednesday, October 1, 2014 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Paul Werle, Ed Burch, Brian Still and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was not present. Ken Carroll was not present

Mayor Pence invited the public to present comments to the Governing Body.

Approval of Agenda:

Burch moved to approve the Agenda. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes:

Still moved to approve the Minutes of the September 17, 2014 Council Meeting. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Community Center Coordinator: Misc. Items.

Jodi Reid commented that the Fall Festival was a success and made about \$1500.00 after expenses.

Mayor Pence commented that he spoke to a couple of people in reference to the Community Center purchasing or leasing an ice machine. He commented that in his opinion, it would be cheaper to buy ice as it is needed.

Bills of the month.

Burch commented that he has reviewed the bills of the month and found them to be acceptable.

City Foreman: Misc. Items.

Nations commented that the 1 Ton truck needs all six tires replaced and that he priced them at \$160 each not including mounting, balancing and disposal. He commented that one of the dump trucks needs three tires at a cost of \$345.00 each.

Still moved to authorize Nations to spend up to \$3,000 on tire replacing the tires. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Nations commented that he would like to purchase oil for chip sealing streets next year at \$3.62 a gallon. He commented that 6,000 gallons would enable him to chip seal 12 blocks.

Werle moved to authorize Nations to purchase 6,000 gallons of oil at \$3.62 a gallon. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

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Nations commented that the plans for the Dollar General only show a small piece of sidewalk being replaced , leaving 145 ft. without any sidewalk. The Contractor for Dollar General gave the City a quote of \$2,900 to put in 145 ft. of sidewalk 4 ft wide.

Burch moved to authorize the expenditure of \$2,900 to put in the 145 ft. of sidewalk. Seconded by Still. Motion carried.

Nations commented has had a couple of people ask him about there being no parking in the 200 block of Elm Street on the east side and inquired if it should be extended to the north to include the 100 block of Elm Street on the east side.

Nations commented that there is a problem with a car obstructing traffic, parking partially in the road on Walnut Street , just south of the railroad tracks on the west side


Werle commented that he would like to see the plat and verify whether that house has parking for the vehicle before the city makes any decision.

Burch moved to extend no parking on Elm Street from 14<sup>th</sup> street north to Riley Ave. on the east side. Seconded by Werle. Motion carried.

Werle inquired of the police officer in attendance as to whether RCPD has an ordinance they follow for panhandling. The policer officer commented that Manhattan has an ordinance they follow.

Burch moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Werle . Motion carried.
