The Regular Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled on Wednesday, July 01, 2015 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Roger Graham, Ken Carroll, Jim Arp, Eladio Reid and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was not present. Ed Burch was not present.

Mayor Pence invited the public to present comments to the Governing Body.

Approval of Agenda:

Carroll moved to approve the Agenda. Seconded by Reid. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes:

Carroll moved to approve the minutes from the 6/17/15 Council Meeting. Seconded by Graham. Motion carried.

Consideration of Ordinance Number 706 an Ordinance Placing Stop Signs at 13th and 14th and Elm Streets.

Mayor Pence commented that he spoke with Pat Cox at BG Consultants and that Cox stated that his original assessment hadn't changed and he would recommend against placing the stop signs on Elm Street unless the City wanted to do a Traffic Flow Study, which would cost between \$15,000-\$17,000.

Attorney Irvine commented that he felt it was ill advised to go against the Engineers recommendations. He commented that he felt the City should consult with the Engineer to see if there might be other options.

Arp moved to adopt an Ordinance placing Stop Signs on Elm Street at 9th, 12th, 13th and 14th Streets. Seconded by Reid. Arp and Reid voted in favor. Graham and Carroll voted against. Mayor Pence voted against. Motion failed.

City Foreman: Misc. Items.

Nations presented the council with two proposals for a 33" Heavy Duty mower for \$1299 each. He commented that the mower would help them in mowing properties that were on the weed/grass abatement list.

Reid moved to approve the purchase of a 33" Heavy Duty mower for \$1299. Seconded by Graham. Carroll voted against. Motion carried.

Nations commented that one of his part time employees is requesting a pay increase.


Mayor Pence suggested that the issue be discussed during an Executive Session at the next Council Meeting.
