

**ORDINANCE NO. 759**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CURFEW FOR MINORS WITHIN THE CITY OF OGDEN, KANSAS.**


**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF OGDEN, KANSAS:**

**Section 1. Amendment.** That Section 11-201 of the Code of Ordinances is hereby amended, as follows:

11-201. CURFEW FOR MINORS; HOURS OF CURFEW. It shall be unlawful for a person under the age of 18 years to be on, or present in, any public street, avenue, alley, park or other public place in the city, between the hours of 12:00 a.m. on Friday and Saturday nights and 5:00 a.m. the following day, and between the hours of 11:00 p.m. on Sunday through Thursday nights and 5:00 a.m. of the following day, official city time, unless accompanied by his or her parent or guardian, or person having lawful custody and control of his or her person, or unless there exists a reasonable necessity therefor. The fact that the child, unaccompanied by parent, guardian, or other person having legal custody, is found upon any street, alley, or public place after the above-stated times, shall be prima facie evidence that the child is there unlawfully and that no reasonable excuse exists therefor.


**Section 2. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
